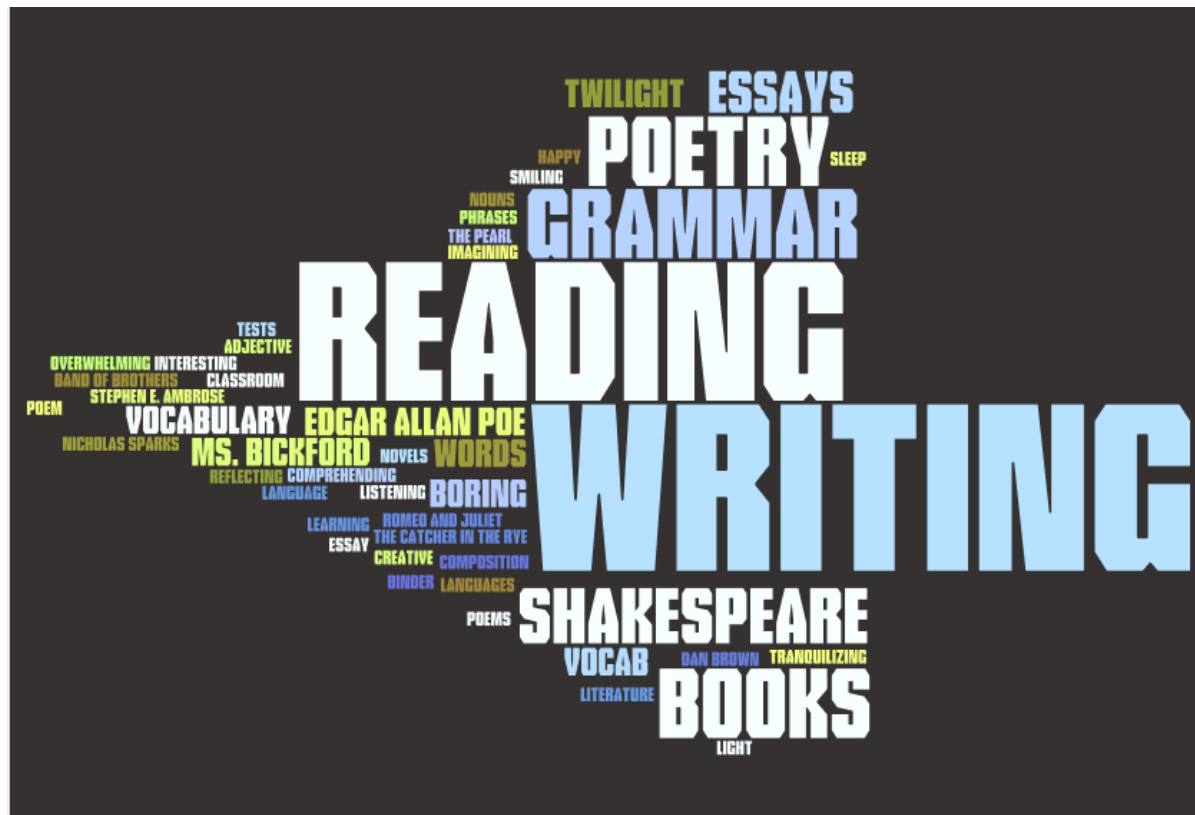

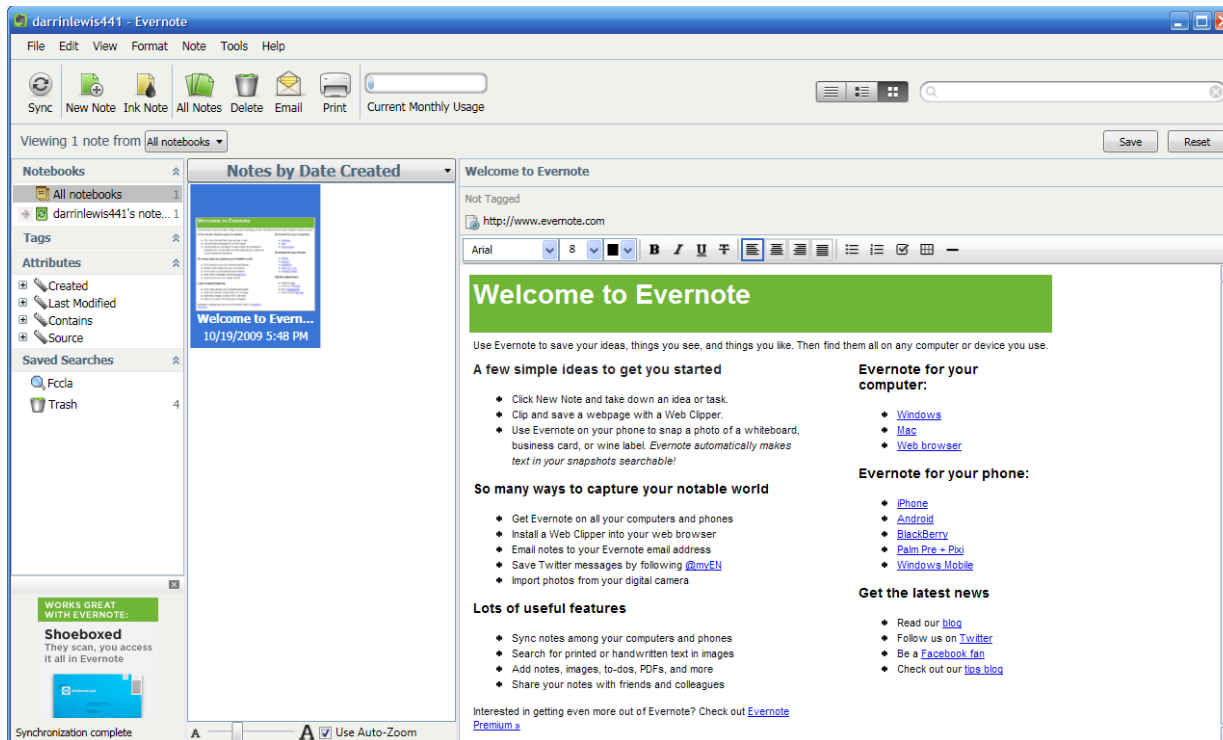
Wordle


