Driving Directions: Take business 20 through Fort Dodge to South 12th Street. Turn north on South 12 Street and drive several blocks to the Fusion Glass and Tillies Quilt shops which will be on the east side of the street. We will drive as a caravan to both Willow Ridge and the Community Orchard. You can also set your GPS to the addresses listed above.

Tillies Quilts (17 South 12th Street): Jo Seltz will be our tour guide and teacher for our quilting, weaving or spinning projects. This quilt shop has a great selection of the latest products and an excellent workshop area in the back for workshops and demonstrations.

Fusion Glass (21 South 12th Street): Shari Burke will be our tour guide and teacher for our glass projects. This newly remodeled business has a beautiful inventory of merchandise to purchase, and is a wonderful place to design and create your own personal glass projects.

Projects to Construct - Several projects to design and construct are available at Tillies Quilts and Fusion Glass. These include fabric postcards, Christmas ornaments and decorative items for the home. Costs will start at \$5.00 and go up and will be paid to the individual businesses at the workshop. Smaller projects could be created at both shops, or a single larger project could be created at one shop.

Willow Ridge (1788 Madison Ave.): This golf course and restaurant is an extension of Iowa Central Community College’s culinary and turf management programs. Students get hands-on, real-world experience at this facility. Chef Michael Hirst and his students will be presenting culinary demonstrations while preparing our lunch. We will also have the opportunity to learn more about the golf course and the turf management program.

Lunch: Lunch will be a surprise fall themed menu, prepared and served by the Iowa Central Community College culinary students. This multi-course meal will be prepared and served at the Willow Ridge Restaurant – the ICC student “restaurant-classroom”! The entrée will be a choice of pork or chicken.

Community Apple Orchard (2237 160th Street): The Fort Dodge Community Orchard will be the final activity of the day. Bev Baedke will be our tour guide of the well-known and highly respected orchard and all of their amenities. The tour will include an opportunity to learn about an entrepreneurial business that has stood the test of time. Items can be purchased in the gift shop or the tea room after the tour.

Cost: The registration fee will include the cost of the meal at Willow Ridge, but will not include project construction costs, personal items purchased or food at the orchard.
